Average warm episode effects of El Niño on the climate, December–February

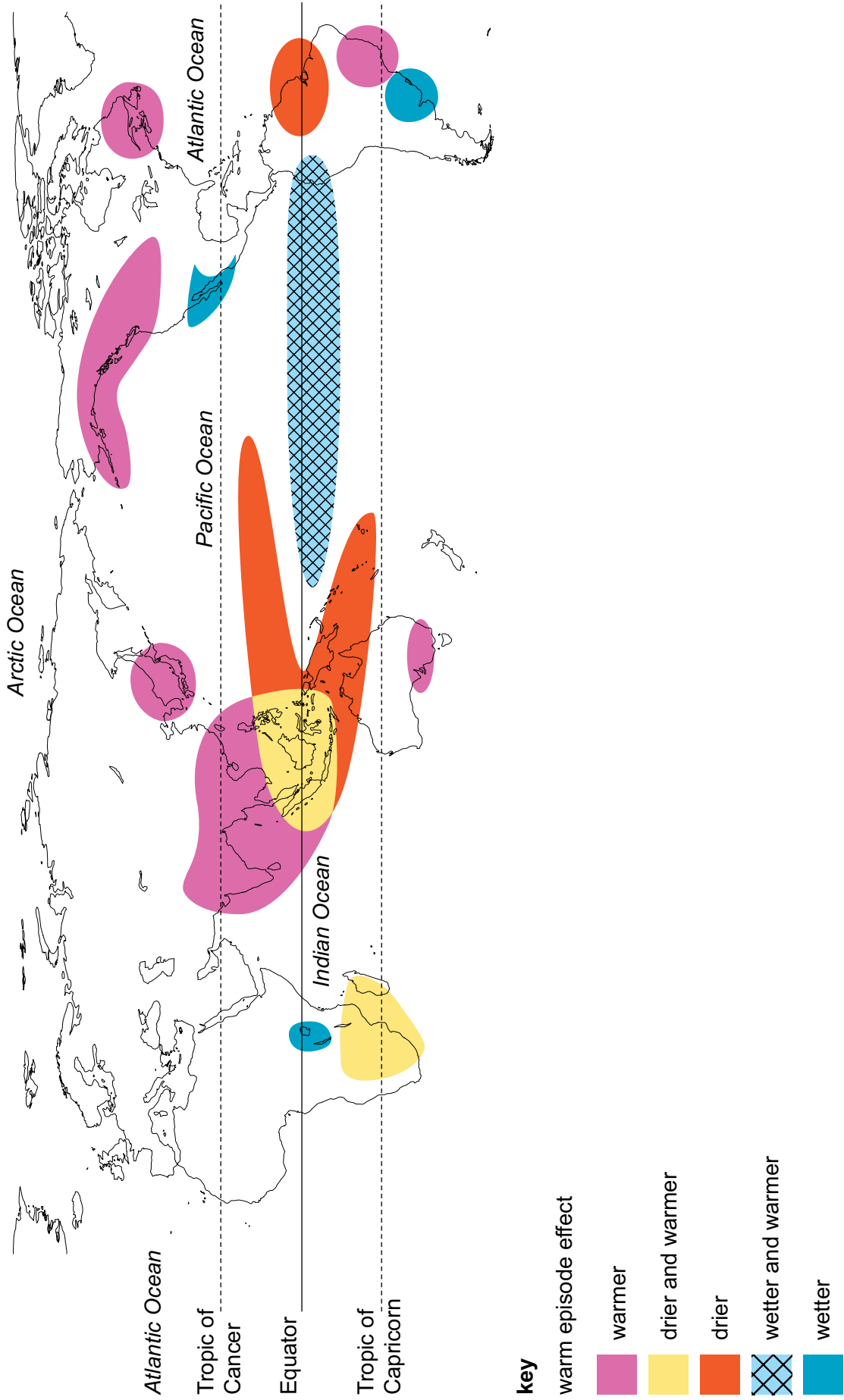
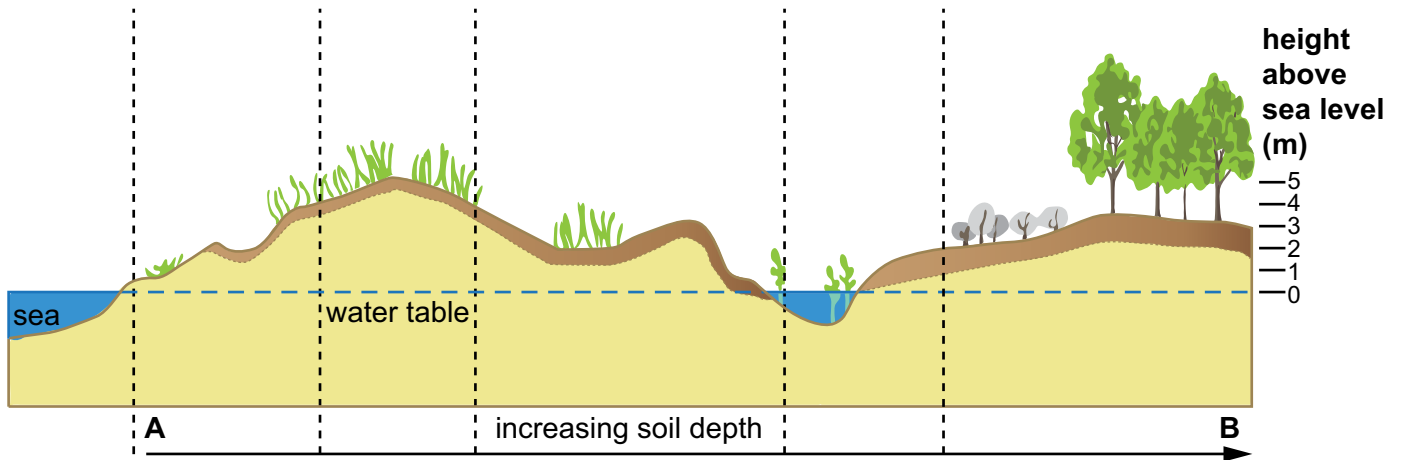

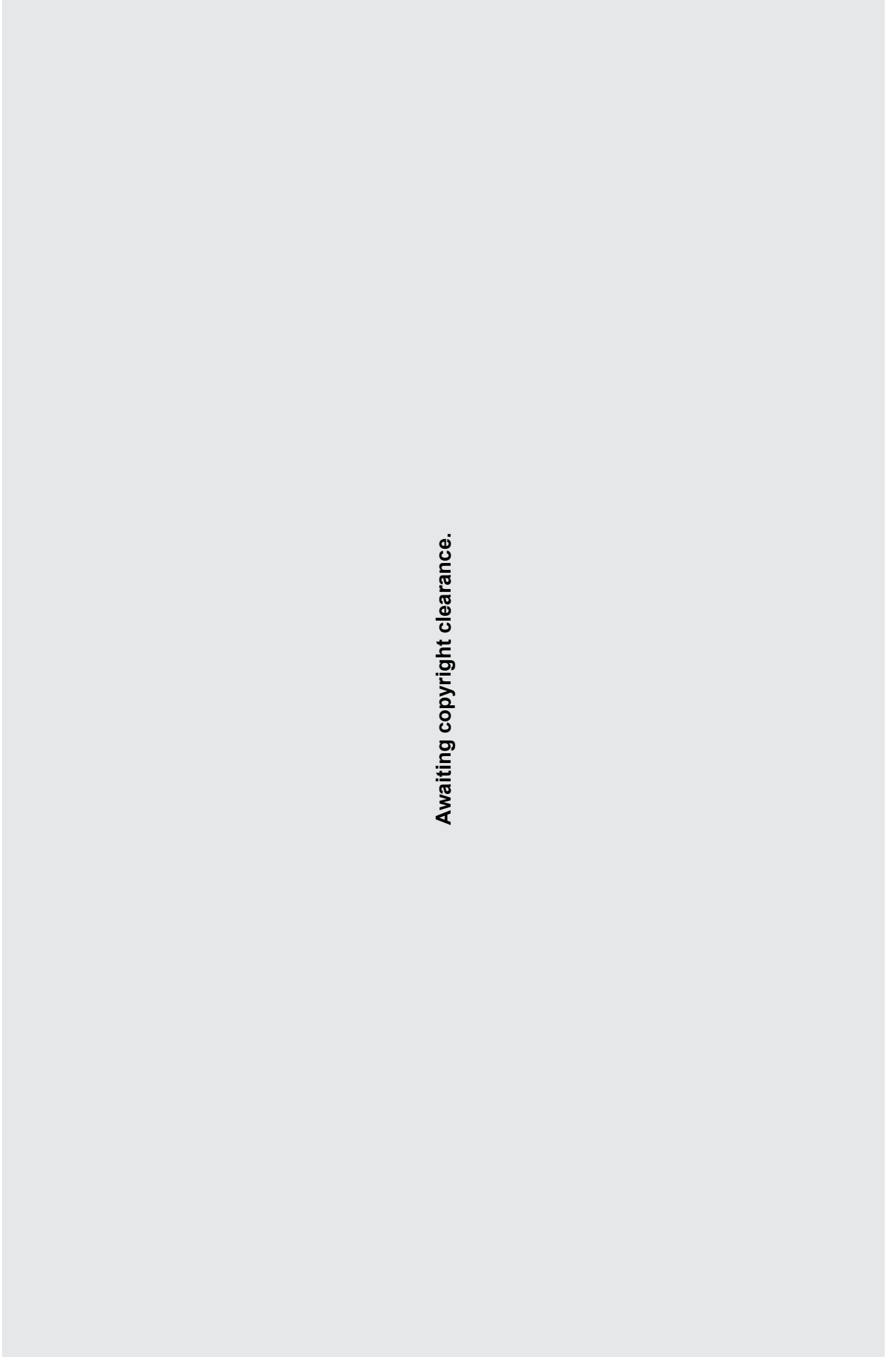
