

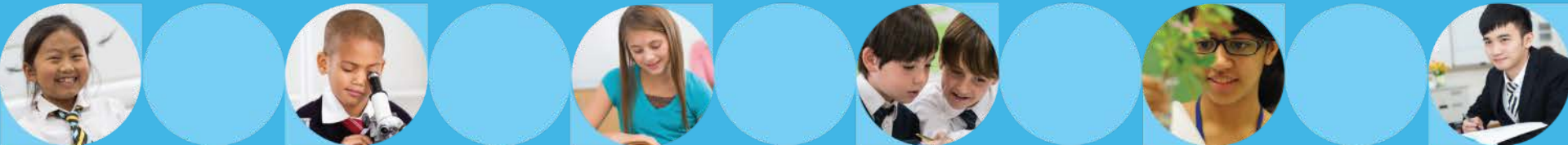

  - ▶ Nine in ten are more likely to employ a candidate who demonstrates achievements beyond grades.

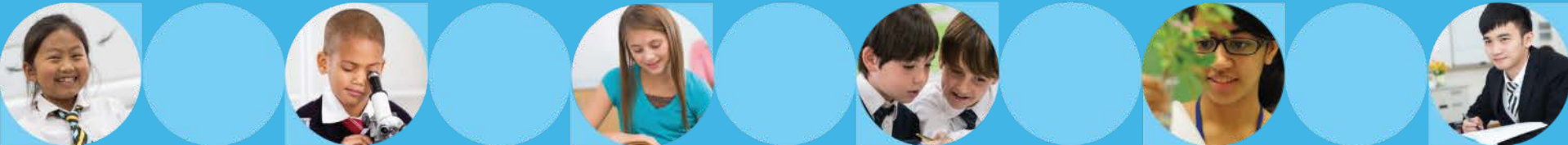


# Recognition
